

In order to ensure that proper suspension adjustments are performed on the above mentioned Ski-Doo models, we are pleased to introduce new suspension adjustment decals.

The decals will be applied at the factory. One decal will be affixed to each vehicle.

Located on the pulley guard, the decal describes settings for optimum comfort according to load on a given Ski-Doo model.

Although the decals have a similar look, they all have varying information depending on suspension characteristics.

B)

The "customer satisfaction index", will contain questions about the decal and its contents thus providing valuable input for future decals.

C)

There will be a tag attached to the ignition key of each vehicle reading the following:

"Dear Customer, Have you asked your dealer to adjust the suspension to your riding style?".

The tag <u>must</u> only be removed by the new owner.


